Trusting God When Your Situation Seems Hopeless Daniel 1:1-21 (Message 1)

"O God, when I lose hope because my plans have come to nothing... then help me to remember that your love is always greater than my disappointments and your plans for my life are always better than my dreams." ~Unknown

There are four truths we must remember about trusting God when our situations seem hopeless.

1st Truth: Troubles and tragedies will arise in your life

Christians are <u>not exempt</u> from the struggles of living through <u>difficulties</u> that bring <u>hurt</u> and loss.

Daniel 1:1-3; 2 Chronicles 36:5, 6; Matthew 5: 44, 45

2nd Truth: You do not go through your trials and troubles alone

God does not leave you to <u>experience</u> troubles in <u>your strength</u>, your <u>wisdom</u> or your ability.

3rd Truth: Stay steadfast and focus on your obedience to God

Your obedience to God <u>during</u> troubled times will <u>shine</u> like the <u>stars</u> on the darkest nights.

Daniel 1:5, 8

4th Truth: God will increase your faith and enlarge your portion

Obedience to God brings His <u>blessings</u> and an increase of your <u>influence</u> to impact more lives for Christ.
