The Spiritual Side of Prayer Daniel 10: 1-21 NIV

"If prayer stands as the place where God and human beings meet, then I must learn about prayer. Most of my struggles in the Christian life circle around the same two themes: why God doesn't act the way we want God to, and why I don't act the way God wants me to. Prayer is the precise point where these themes converge." ~Philip Yancy

There are four facts about the spiritual side of prayer we must understand to deepen our prayer life.

1st Fact: Jesus hears and responds to our prayers immediately

Daniel 10:4-6; Daniel 12:7; Revelation 1:12-18; 1 John 5: 14-15 "Prayer is the rope that pulls God and man together: But, it doesn't pull God down to us: It pulls us up to Him." ~Billy Graham

2nd Fact: Angels actively participate in delivering answers to our prayers

Daniel 10:10-12; Hebrews 1:14; Hebrews 13:2; 2 Kings 6: 15-17
*The angels act as <u>messengers</u> to bring about God's <u>Will</u> in the natural world.
*The <u>interactions</u> on the other end of your prayers are <u>supernatural</u>!
"The great comfort in knowing that angels minister to believers in Christ is that God Himself sends them to us." ~Billy Graham

3rd Fact: Demons fight to resist God's answers from reaching your life

📖 Daniel 10:12-14; Ephesians 6:12

*Prayer is spiritual warfare!

*Demons are <u>territorial</u>. They will <u>challenge</u> angels sent from God to fulfill His plan and <u>delay</u> His answers from reaching you.

4th Fact: God gives you strength to receive His answer by faith to fulfill His Will.

Daniel 10:17-19; Deuteronomy 31:6; Isaiah 41:10
