Joshua 1:1-9 NIV

There are four virtues that guide us to live and die with honor.

1st Virtue

Love in Action

For love to fulfill its <u>dynamics</u>, it must be expressed through actions and behaviors.

v. 1:2b "... get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites."

• John 15:13 NLT "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends."

2nd Virtue

Loyalty to Persevere

Loyalty is a virtue of <u>character</u> which measures a person's faithfulness.

v. 1:5 ". . . As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you."

3rd Virtue

Courage

<u>Courageous</u> people live in honor because they have developed <u>mental</u> and <u>moral</u> strength to venture and persevere through <u>fear</u>.

v. 1:6 "Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people."

4th Virtue

Lifetime of Learning

Knowledge ripened with <u>wisdom</u> then exercised through faith will guide Christians to live a life with <u>honor</u>.
